

**Chapter 45**  
**SANITARY CODE**

ARTICLE I

**§ 45-3.       Violations. [Amended X-XX-2010 by L.L. No. XX, 2010]**

Every person who willfully violates or refuses to comply with or resists any ordinance, order, regulation or resolution of the Board of Health of this village shall be subject to the arrest, action, penalty, fine and punishment provided, and declared in the Public Health Law, Chapter 25, of the General Law of 1893, and the laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, of which notice must be taken.

In addition to those penalties proscribed by State Law, A any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or failing to comply therewith shall be liable to a civil penalty of not less than one two hundred fifty dollars (~~\$100~~250.) nor more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.) together with the costs of prosecution, or to imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months, or both, and in addition thereto, such violation shall constitute disorderly conduct, and any person committing such violation shall be a disorderly person. For subsequent violations, the penalty shall be increased to not less than five hundred dollars (\$500.) nor more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.) and, as such, liable to a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months, or both; and in addition, if such person be a plumber, he shall forfeit the license granted him by the Board. Each and every day that such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
