Due to a work conflict I cannot attend the Zoning Board Meeting tonight but I would appreciate my comments being read into the minutes. As a former Village Trustee, current Zoning Board member, and resident of Webber Park I want to share my strong support for The Open Door be allowed to proceed with plans to relocate to the old Peter Grotto Building at the intersection of Broadway and New Broadway at the entrance to Webber park at New Broadway. This important asset to the Village provides critical services to a largely underserved population within Sleepy Hollow. Their proposed use of this building will be an important improvement to what has been a neglected property for many years. In fact, I suspect that this particular use may make that intersection more safe due to the importance of providing safe access across Broadway. In the long term, The Open Door's move will also make it easier for future Boards to support the redevelopment of Beekman Avenue as the GM site comes on line and the inner Village gets greater attention. For these reasons I urge the Zoning Board to approve their application.
