

Cooking oil and grease clog village infrastructure. Our tax dollars are spent cleaning and repairing. Let grease cool and put in trash or pour into a non-recyclable container and discard.



2

Leaf litter & grass clippings contribute to pollution and Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs). HABs cause fish & wildlife die-offs. In 2025, dogs died from drinking HAB-affected water in the Hudson & its tributaries. People cannot safely boat, kayak or fish.



3

Whatever goes into storm drains ends up untreated in the Pocantico or the Hudson. Do not put chemicals or animal waste in village drains.





If you use a commercial car wash, water is recycled and safely sent to treatment facilities. If you wash your car at home, do it on a lawn or gravel & dump your soapy bucket in the sink.

Sleepy Hollow has many buried streams and low lying areas prone to flooding. When leaves and other materials clog drains, streets flood and cause costly repairs.

ONLY RAIN DOWN THE DRAIN

As we head into the holiday season, the Department of Public Works is asking for your help to keep our Village and waterways clean. Sleepy Hollow has two different drainage systems, and both need attention this time of year.

Storm Drains — Keep Leaves Out

When leaves pile up near storm drains, they block water flow and carry pollution into our streams and the Hudson River.

You can help:

- Bag or compost leaves
- Keep storm drains clear near your home
- Report blocked drains or flooding to DPW

Kitchen Drains — Keep Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) Out

Holiday cooking often means extra grease, gravy, and oil — but pouring them down the drain can cause sewer clogs and backups. You can help:

- Pour cooled grease into a sealed container and place it in the trash
- Wipe greasy pans with a paper towel before washing
- Use sink strainers to catch food scraps

Everything that goes down your sink flows to the sanitary sewer system and blockages cause costly repairs. Thank you for doing your part this season. Your small actions make a big difference in protecting Sleepy Hollow's infrastructure, and the Hudson and Pocantico Rivers we all share.

Recycle Tips

WESTCHESTER RECYCLES

Sorting your paper, cardboard and other recyclables is quick and easy. Just focus on tossing all mixed paper into one bin and plastic, glass, and metal into another. Please **EMPTY** and **RINSE** all containers and flatten and break down cardboard boxes.



TIPS FOR RECYCLING RIGHT!

- Keep it Loose! Don't bag your recyclables.
- All containers are empty, rinsed, & dry
- Place shredded paper in paper bags.
- Cardboard is flattened & broken down

Members of **Sustainable Sleepy Hollow** met recently with Westchester County officials and came away with recycling tips and information. Here are some of the “keep it simple” tenets they covered regarding what can and cannot be recycled:

Commingled (metal, glass or plastic) containers:

- YES: Any plastic item with a recycle symbol - there's a market for all symbols
- YES: Tetra packs (juice and shelf-stable liquid boxes) if empty and rinsed
- YES: Aluminum foil, as long as no food or plastic is stuck to it
- NO: Plastic bags in or around recyclables - they clog the machinery and should instead go to bins at grocery stores
- NO: Items smaller than a credit card, as they fall through the machinery
- NO: Items made of mixed materials, like blister packs stuck to paper - trash them
- NO: Items marked "compostable" - they will get rejected
- NO: broken glass - it's a hazard to workers
- CAREFUL: Empty food and drink container contents and scrape or rinse off as much residue as you can - a small streak is OK - but don't waste hot water, detergent and energy washing items
- CAREFUL: Leave small caps and lids on, or trash them

Paper:

- YES: Pizza boxes without food, but tear off and compost grease-soaked parts
- YES: Small staples on office paper
- YES: Paper with crayon or paint
- NO: Items with glue, lots of sticky labels, metal parts or lots of tape - they jam the machinery
- NO: Books, even paperbacks - donate them to the Library if in good condition
- NO: Metal paperclips, binder clips, clasps or large packing staples
- NO: Adhesive stickers
- NO: Plastic- or wax-coated items, like frozen-food boxes
- CAREFUL: Home-shredded paper needs to be in a closed paper bag or box

Recycling Info:

- 64,000 tons were recycled last year, which netted \$5.9M overall for the County
- Every ton recycled saves municipalities \$130 versus trashing
- Overall, 10% of what comes to MRF is rejected as trash; 95-97% of the rest is sold to marketers



ONLY RAIN DOWN THE DRAIN

Con la llegada de las fiestas navideñas, el Departamento de Obras Públicas solicita su colaboración para mantener limpios nuestro pueblo y sus vías fluviales. Sleepy Hollow cuenta con dos sistemas de drenaje distintos, y ambos requieren atención durante esta época del año.

Desagües pluviales: mantenga las hojas fuera
Cuando las hojas se acumulan cerca de los desagües pluviales, bloquean el flujo de agua y transportan la contaminación a nuestros arroyos y al río Hudson.

Tú puedes ayudar:

- Recoger o compostar hojas
- Mantén despejadas las alcantarillas cerca de tu casa.
- Informe a DPW sobre desagües obstruidos o inundaciones.

Desagües de cocina: evite que las grasas, aceites y lubricantes (FOG) entren en el desagüe.

Cocinar durante las fiestas suele significar usar más grasa, salsa y aceite, pero botarlos por el desagüe puede causar obstrucciones y atascos en las alcantarillas.

Tú puedes ayudar:

- Bote la grasa enfriada en un recipiente sellado y tírelo a la basura.
- Limpie las sartenes grasientas con una toalla de papel antes de lavarlas.
- Utilice coladores de fregadero para recoger los restos de comida.

Todo lo que se tira por el desagüe termina en el sistema de alcantarillado sanitario y los atascos provocan reparaciones costosas.

Gracias por su colaboración esta temporada. Sus pequeñas acciones marcan una gran diferencia en la protección de la infraestructura de Sleepy Hollow y de los ríos Hudson y Pocantico que todos compartimos.

Consejos de reciclaje

WESTCHESTER RECYCLES

Sorting your paper, cardboard and other recyclables is quick and easy. Just focus on tossing all mixed paper into one bin and plastic, glass, and metal into another. Please **EMPTY** and **RINSE** all containers and flatten and break down cardboard boxes.

El grupo de Sustainable Sleepy Hollow se reunieron recientemente con funcionarios del condado de Westchester y obtuvieron los siguientes consejos e información sobre reciclaje: Aquí tenéis algunos de los principios de "mantener la simplicidad" que trataron sobre qué se puede y qué no se puede reciclar:

Envases mezclados (metal, vidrio o plástico):

- Sí: Cualquier artículo de plástico con el símbolo de reciclaje; hay mercado para todos los símbolos.
- Sí: Envases Tetra Pak (zumos y líquidos de larga duración) si están vacíos y enjuagados.

- SÍ: Papel de aluminio, siempre y cuando no tenga restos de comida ni plástico adheridos.
- NO: No se permiten bolsas de plástico en los contenedores de reciclaje ni cerca de ellos; obstruyen la maquinaria y deberían depositarse en los contenedores de los supermercados.
- NO: Los objetos más pequeños que una tarjeta de crédito, ya que se caen a través de la maquinaria.
- NO: Artículos hechos de materiales mixtos, como blísteres pegados a papel: deséchelos.
- NO: Los artículos marcados como “compostables” serán rechazados.
- NO: vidrios rotos; representan un peligro para los trabajadores.
- PRECAUCIÓN: Vacíe el contenido de los envases de comida y bebida y raspe o enjuague la mayor cantidad de residuos posible; una pequeña mancha es normal, pero no desperdicie agua caliente, detergente ni energía lavando los envases.
- ¡CUIDADO!: Deje las tapitas y los tapones puestos o tírelos a la basura.

Papel:

- SÍ: Cajas de pizza sin comida, pero se pueden arrancar y compostar las partes empapadas de grasa.
- SÍ: Grapas pequeñas en papel de oficina
- SÍ: Papel con crayón o pintura
- NO: Los artículos con pegamento, muchas etiquetas adhesivas, piezas metálicas o mucha cinta adhesiva pueden atascar la maquinaria.
- NO: Libros, incluso de bolsillo: dónelos a la biblioteca si están en buen estado.
- NO: Clips metálicos, pinzas para papel, broches o grapas grandes para embalaje.
- NO: Pegatinas adhesivas
- NO: Artículos recubiertos de plástico o cera, como las cajas de alimentos congelados.
- PRECAUCIÓN: El papel triturado en casa debe guardarse en una bolsa o caja de papel cerrada.

Información sobre reciclaje:

El año pasado se reciclaron 64.000 toneladas, lo que generó un total de \$5.9 millones de dólares para el condado.

Cada tonelada reciclada le ahorra a los municipios \$130 dólares en comparación con el desecho de residuos.

En total, el 10% de lo que llega a la planta de reciclaje se desecha; entre el 95 – 97% del resto de vende a comercializadores.
